## CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS FOR THE EMDEN SONS OF THE AMERICAN LEGION POST #506 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

## **CRITERIA RATING BY POST #506 SELECTION COMMITTEE**

- 1. First consideration will be given to a student who is a child or grandchild of an active or deceased member of Post #506.
- 2. The committee each year shall establish a point scale with no fewer than three and no more than ten points for each of the above criteria.
- 3. The student applicant must be accepted to an accredited educational institution of higher learning.
- 4. Applications for the Sons of the American Legion Post #506 Scholarship Award must be received by the Post no later than May 11<sup>th</sup> of the applicant's senior year.
- 5. A check for \$600.00 which represents the Sons of the American Legion Post #506 Scholarship award will be presented by an officer of the Post at graduation if there is no conflict with other graduation ceremonies.
