**CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS FOR THE
EMDEN SONS OF THE AMERICAN LEGION POST #506 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

- 1. Is the student's plans and goals realistic according to his/her ability?**
- 2. Does the student have the necessary abilities and background to profit from further education?**
- 3. Is the student a responsible follower as well as a dependable leader?**
- 4. Is the student socially adjusted and accepted by his/her peers and those in authority?**
- 5. Does the student demonstrate a sense of obligation to our flag, country and community?**

CRITERIA RATING BY POST #506 SELECTION COMMITTEE

- 1. First consideration will be given to a student who is a child or grandchild of an active or deceased member of Post #506.**
- 2. The committee each year shall establish a point scale with no fewer than three and no more than ten points for each of the above criteria.**
- 3. The student applicant must be accepted to an accredited educational institution of higher learning.**
- 4. Applications for the Sons of the American Legion Post #506 Scholarship Award must be received by the Post no later than May 11th of the applicant's senior year.**
- 5. A check for \$500.00 which represents the Sons of the American Legion Post #506 Scholarship award will be presented by an officer of the Post at graduation if there is no conflict with other graduation ceremonies.**
